Procedures for Assessment – further information and guidance

The Authority has today published a series of documents regarding the procedures for the Assessment of official statistics in accordance with sections 12 and 14 of the Statistics and Registration Service Act 2007:

- Evidence for Assessments: the approach to collecting evidence from statistical producers, users and other stakeholders for the purposes of conducting Assessments.
- Written Evidence for Assessments: further information on the written evidence that will be required from statistical producers.
- User and Stakeholder Questionnaires: the questionnaires to be completed by users and stakeholders
- Sequence of the production and approval of Assessment reports: a step-by-step guide to how Assessment reports are produced and approved for publication.
- Proposed structure of Assessment reports: information on how Assessment reports will be structured.
- Pause and Review exercise: the terms of reference for an exercise to evaluate the Assessment process after the completion of the first tranche of Assessments.
