**April 2014**

- 8 April The collection and analysis of primary care data held by General Practitioners as part of the care.data programme.
- 14 April Revision of ONS statistics on migration and the validity of assumptions made about migrants.
- 14 April The provenance of Department for Work and Pensions statistics on migrant workers in receipt of housing benefit used in a Sunday Telegraph article.
- 24 April The statistical basis for a statement by Gordon Brown in a speech on 22 April 2014 that pensions cost the UK £1,725 per capita in the UK as a whole but Scotland receives £1,805 per capita.
  
- 29 April The publication of statistics on mandatory reconsiderations of applications for Employment and Support Allowance and the powers of Ministers to ask civil servants to ensure such statistics are published.

**May 2014**

- 2 May The presentation of ONS statistics on migration in a campaign leaflet produced by the UK Independence Party.
- 6 May Use, by the Ministry of Justice, of data on the earnings of legal professionals in the course of arguments over legal aid cuts.
- 9 May Accuracy of reporting in the press and on social media of ONS statistics on zero hours.
- 16 May Methods used to produce figures on the amount of tax recovered through HM Revenue and Customs tax compliance work under this government compared to the last.
- 16 May The methodology behind official statistics on employment, and whether government claims about trends in employment can be supported by the current official statistics.
- 19 May The availability of regional council tax statistics which were previously provided by the Department of Communities and Local Government.
- 30 May Statistical basis for Government statements about the number of affordable homes built in the last 13 years.

**June 2014**

- 2 June Comments regarding the appropriateness of the Northern Ireland Tourism Minister's use of tourism statistics in a Belfast Telegraph article in relation to the Programme for Government targets for 2013.
- 3 June Query regarding the evidence behind a statement made by the Minister of State for Energy and Climate Change that the changes to the Energy Company Obligation programme would help more people from March 2015 to March 2017.
- 3 June The potential breach of pre-release access to HM Treasury UK Trade official statistics produced by ONS.
- 11 June Errors in HM Revenue and Customs UK overseas trade with the European Union statistics for April 2014.
- 11 June The use of unpublished data in a ministerial briefing on the number of passport applications received by HM Passport Office.
- 17 June The clarity of concepts and terminology, used in a Daily Mail article published in July 2013, to describe non-UK born and non-UK nationals in relation to the available labour market official statistics.
